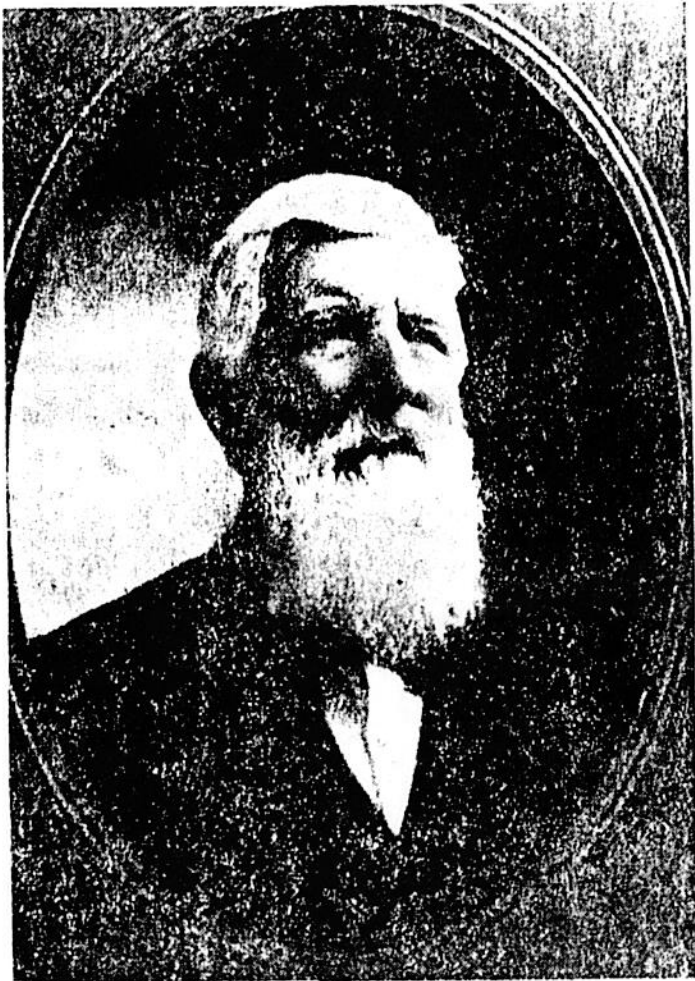

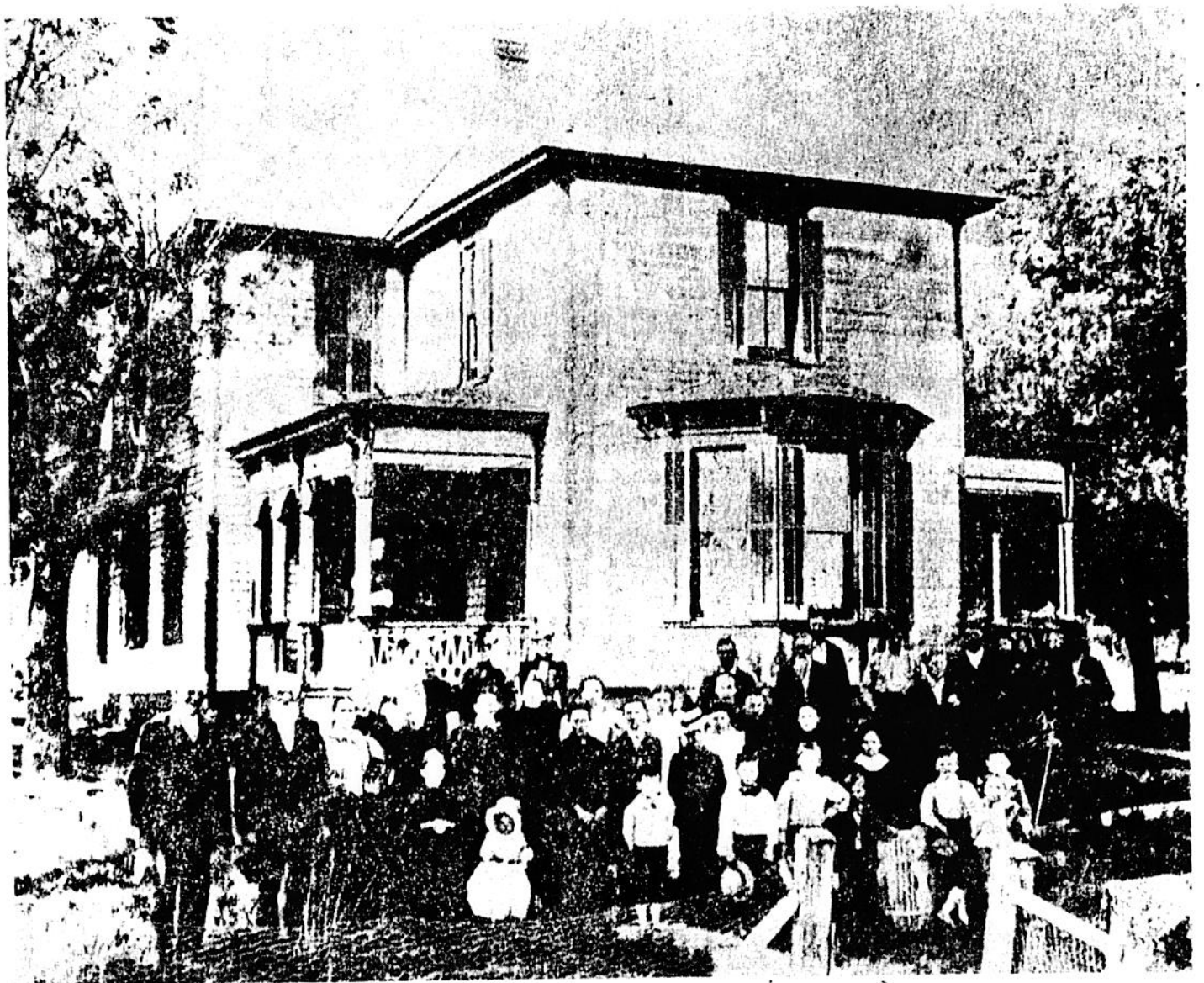

At the farm home of Thomas W. McClintock, near Milton, Missouri. The occasion was the 90th birthday of Leah VanGundy, widow of Rev. John VanGundy, who is seen seated on the

porch. This was in May, 1899, and apparently all the relatives in the community were present. Mrs. VanGundy passed away later that year.

2. I am the daughter of Austin Van Gundy, born in Ross Co. Ohio on 21 June 1856, died in Shenandoah, Iowa on 31 May 1942 and Mary Belle Gray his wife, born in Brown Co. Ohio on 28 Dec. 1857, died in Shenandoah, Iowa on 30 Nov. 1951, married in Tarkio, Missouri on 18 April 1880
3. The said Austin Van Gundy was the son of James Van Gundy born in Ross Co. Ohio on 9 Nov. 1823, died in Craig, Missouri on 6 June 1907, and Rachel Martha Ring his wife, born in Ohio on Oct. 1824, died in Filton, Missouri on 18 April 1899, married in Lancaster, Ohio on July, 1855
4. The said Rachel Martha Ring was the daughter of George Ring born in Ohio on 1787, died in Lancaster, Ohio on 5 April 1862, and Rachel Moore his wife, born in Ohio (?) on Ohio (?), died in Ohio (?), married in Ohio (?) on 1812
5. The said George Ring was the son of Joseph Ring born in Ringtown, Mass. on 3 Nov. 1751, died in Chesterfield, Mass. on 19 April 1796 and Penelope Patch his wife, born in Chesterfield, Mass. on Nov. 1754, died in Lancaster, Ohio on July, 1837, married in Mass. on 7 Dec. 1780
6. The said Joseph Ring was the son of Jonathan Ring born in Maine, Mass. on 23 Dec. 1702, died in Mass. on 1774 and Sarah Mitchell his wife, born in Mass. on 1719, died in Mass. on 1776, married in Mass. on 21 Jan. 1748
7. The said Jonathan Ring was the son of Eleazar Ring born in Plymouth, Mass. on 21 Nov. 1749, died in Mass. on 1666, and Mary Shaw his wife, born in Mass. on 1730, married in Plymouth, Mass. on 11 Jan. 1687
8. The said Eleazar Ring was the son of Andrew Ring born in Leyden, Holland on 1617, died in Plymouth, Mass. on 22 Mar. 1692/3 and Deborah Hopkins his wife, born in Plymouth, Mass. on 1622, died in Plymouth, Mass. on 1659, married in Plymouth, Mass. (1st wife) on 23 April 1646
9. The said Deborah Hopkins was the daughter of Stephen Hopkins born in bap. Bristol, England on 29 Oct. 1585, died in Mass. on 27 July 1644, and Eliza Fisher his wife, born in England on England, died in Mass. on 1640/44, married in Mass. on Mass.

AS IT SEEMS TO ME

While always delighted to acquire new information of any date on the now widely scattered VanGundy branches, the undersigned has felt it just as valuable to attempt a listing of more recent generations while the information is available, as to undertake too much inquiry into the origins of the hardy fathers who first made the name a permanent one in this new world. The details of their genealogical patterns have faded into the mists of time, and there are many differing tales related as to who all brought the name overseas. The first and most authentic sounding of these came in a letter written July 17, 1931 by the late J. D. VanGundy of Lancaster, Ohio. His chart shows a Peter VanGundy as the original immigrant, and traces clearly the line of descent from that family down to J. D. himself, to this writer, and to many others of the present generation. A notation claimed "We have a certificate of his birth from the Swiss government (though no one now can locate this certificate). The letter also has a list of seven children left by this Peter VanGundy when he died in 1763. This same list of his children, with name of their mother not given, is found among the records of Wm. Henry Egle, author of History of Dauphin & Lebanon Co., Pa. Also, this same list of these children with some information of their approximate dates of birth and the name of Peter's wife can be found in the Orphans Court Records of Lancaster Co., Pa. From other sources come the story of Peter the immigrant "settling at Reading, Pa", and another that "he was buried in a cemetery on a hill overlooking Harrisburg, Pa." And Rupp's History of Lancaster Co., Pa. is quoted as "showing clearly that the father of Christian VanG. was killed by the Indians and was buried in Earl Township, Lancaster., Pa."

A chart of fathers of his branch furnished by Ross G. VanGundy of Los Angeles, states that "Peter VanGundy, a Hollander, and two nephews" were founders of the family. Harvey VanGundy of Tahlequah, Okla. writes that his "father and a twin brother were brought over from Holland by an old lady, and they settled in Ohio." And so it goes.

In view of the above and other incomplete reports on our early history; it is gratifying to remember that an organization called "The VanGundy Family Association" was formed in 1961, and that Mrs. C. C. Meyer, 212 Holland Rd., Severna Park, Maryland, who is not only a VanGundy descendant but also an author and editor of genealogical publications, has consented to serve as our Director of Research. With the informational and financial aid of all of us, she will do all that any one can toward ferreting out the "missing links" of early VanGundy history. All inquiries and new information as well as contributions to the Research Fund may be sent directly to Mrs. Meyer. At last report about \$50.00 had been received and used for professional research, with results not quite as good as hoped for. However, we are accustomed to many "dead end streets" in our efforts to pursue this hobby as individuals, and a real "familytree fan" never loses hope that the next try will turn out better. So as this listing of one family group, compiled by your President, is sent out he is glad for the opportunity to write this word in the interest of renewed cooperation by every one in our united effort.

GENEALOGICAL LISTING OF CERTAIN VANGUNDY FAMILIES

SECTION ONE

Notes:

It has seemed advisable to issue the VanGundy data at hand in sections, the chief reason being that the record of this most nearly complete group might as well be in use while the other branches are being more nearly completed and prepared.

This Section One undertakes to cover only the lineage of the Rev. John VanGundy 1799-1874, tracing his origin as now understood back to the previously indicated immigrant, Peter VanGundy, who was apparently his great grandfather.

This record was initiated in 1883 by Rev. William A. VanGundy 1855-1948. It was copied in part in 1954 by Bliss A. VanGundy, who then added additional items as soon as new information could be obtained.

In using the record for reference it is well to bear in mind the following rules which have been adhered to in it's preparation:

Immediate families are separated from each other by a short line of asterisks, as \* \* \* \* \*

The VanGundy parent involved is listed as head of the family, even if that be the mother.

Only the maiden name, or other name prior to the marriage, is used in listing female parents.

The family records of married children follow immediately after that of their parents, in proper sequence.

In all cases the birth date, or life term in years, is placed immediately after the name of an individual.

Question marks indicate "subject to correction" or "unknown".

1. Peter VanGundy (the immigrant). He died prior to March 26, 1763 in Lancaster County, Pa., leaving a wife (name not given) and seven children, as follows: John 1740, Christian 1743, Peter, Jr., 1746, Magdalena 1748, Joseph 1750, Benjamin 1752, David 1754.

1.1 Peter VanGundy, Jr. 1746? (Son of Peter VanGundy -1753).

1.2 John VanGundy 1767? (Son of Peter VanGundy, Jr. 1746?).  
This John VanGundy died 10-27-1860 in Fountain Co. Ind. ? ?

Children: John, Jr. 1-13-1799 in Pa.; Myers and two others whose names were illegible, all three died in Indiana; David 4-6-1805? in Pa.; Peter, died in Ind.; Sarah 4-6-1808 in Pa.?

John VanGundy, Jr. Jan. 13, 1799 in Pa. (Son of John VanGundy 1767-1860 ?). Was a "Local Preacher". Came from Pa. to Ohio as a young man, settling in Ross County, where all his children were born. In 1859, apparently bringing most of his family, he came to Atchison Co. Mo., locating near the future site of the town of Milton, Mo. about 12 miles south of Tarkio, Mo. He died August 7, 1874, and was buried in the Milton Cemetery. His first wife was Margaret Search 10-15-1802. They were married 3-24-1821. She died July 6, 1833.

Her children were Jones 2-27-1822 ; James 11-9-1823 ; Jane 1-15-1826 ; John 3-27-1829 ; David 11-5-1832 who died 8-5-1833.

Second wife was Leah VanGundy ? 5-11-1809 Ohio (is said to have been a sister of the first wife, but the marriage license reads as shown here) They were married 1-10-1835. This writer was present at the gathering of a large group of relatives in honor of her 90th birthday at the home of her granddaughter, Mrs. Thomas McClintock, east of Milton, Mo. It was her last birthday ; she died 10-14-1899.

Her children were Margaret 6-29-1836 ; Samuel 1-30-1838 ; Sarah 2-5-1843 ; Rachael 11-15-1847 ; William 4-26-1850.

In view of the important role taken for so many years in the life of the community by Rev. John VanGundy and his family group, space may be spared for a few high points of the historical data which Mrs. Bill W. Woodward generously took time out to lift for us from the reference books of the Atchison County Library at Rock Port, Mo. In addition to tilling well their acres of rich Missouri soil, these sturdy folk became interested in other activities tending toward community development. About 1861 John VanGundy bought a mill which had been in operation on the Big Tarkio Creek for several years, and two or three years later VanGundy and Co. erected near it a new water power flour mill at a cost of \$15000.00. In 1866 a saw mill was added. On November 19, 1867 the town of Milton, Mo. was laid out by John VanGundy, Sr. and wife. Three years later a plat of VanGundy & Co's addition to the town was filed in the office of the Circuit Clerk of Atchison County. About this time, or perhaps earlier, a Methodist Episcopal Church was organized, and among the charter members were listed John VanGundy, Sr., Leah VanGundy, M. A. VanGundy, S. VanGundy, and M. H. VanGundy. A new frame church building costing \$1500.00 was erected in 1870 (this writer attended services there many times during 1900 and 1901, also once in the early winter of 1906). Also, the Masonic Lodge was an early interest of the family connection. Samuel and John VanGundy were among the officers chosen when Irish Grove Lodge No. 483, A. F. and A. M. was organized in August, 1874; and their names appeared on the charter dated October 16, 1874. These two men also served as officers during four of the seven years following, and in 1879 Alexander VanGundy was elected J. W. The lodge owned and held its meetings in the second floor hall of a frame building completed in Milton in the spring of 1874 by John and Samuel VanGundy at a cost of \$3300.00. The chapter was said to be in a prosperous condition, with a membership of 46.

What a cogent commentary is this bit of history on the ability of Father Time to bring changes ! ! As this is written, all of the above good people mentioned are long gone, and even the town of Milton, Missouri is but a fast fading memory ! ! !

Jones VanGundy 2-27-1822 Ross Co. Ohio (Son of John VanGundy, Sr. 1799-1874). Died 7-8-1882 in Atchison County, Mo. His wife was Eliza Swain Shurtleoff 12-11-1811 Fleming Co. Ky. Married in 1858. She died 12-27-1880 in St. Joseph, Mo.

No children.

James VanGundy 11-9-1823 Ross Co. Ohio (Son of John VanGundy, Sr. 1799-1874). Came to Mo. in 1865. Died 6-2-1907 at Craig, Mo.

His first wife was Ann Elizabeth Moore 10-12-1827; they married 3-8-1849. She died 8-21-1851 in Ohio.

Her children were Alexander 2-9-1850 and Mary E. 7-21-1851. His second wife was Rachel Martha Ring 2-22-1825, to whom he was married on 8-15-1855. She was a daughter of George & Rachel Moore Ring, and had a twin brother. At first the twins were named George & Martha Washington Ring, but when the boy died as an infant the girl's name was changed to Rachel Martha. She died 4-18-1899.

Her children were Austin 6-21-1856; George 1-28-1860; Angeline b. 5-3-1862, and d. 8-19-1904 in Atch. Co., Mo.; and John 3-7-1864 in Ohio, who also d. in Atch. Co. Mo. on 10-18-1884.

His third wife was Mrs. Lincy Fick, if correctly spelled, and it is regretted that to date no data on their short but pleasant life together has been found. This writer remembers the lady as she was a visitor in the parental home about 1901. It may serve to venture that they were probably married about 1897, and that Mrs. VanGundy passed away around 1905.

To his young nephews, of whom this writer was one, "Uncle James" was a fascinating if somewhat awesome person. His tall rather gaunt figure, somewhat fierce eyes under overhanging brows, and gruff almost guttural tones made a deep impression every one of the few times we saw him. At his little sale prior to leaving the farm, the only time I can recall being at his home, I bought a light log chain as the only purchase I could make at the first public sale in my experience. Price \$1.75 ! Uncle James visited us in our Osborne County, Kans. home, probably in the spring of 1906, only a few months over a year before his death. We never saw him again.

Alexander VanGundy 2-9-1850 (Son of James VanGundy 1823-1907) was b. in Ross County, Ohio and came to Atchison Co. Mo. in 1865. Active in agricultural pursuits as a youth, he became especially interested in fruit growing and in March, 1878 acquired a farm of 255 acres in the hill country back from the Missouri River just a few miles west of Milton, Mo. Here he put out an orchard of 1400 apple trees, 800 peach, 120 plum, 750 grape vines, some pear trees, and other fruit. He was given much credit for his attempt to develop this industry. About 1902 he left the farm and the County, and removed his family to Denver, Colo. where he later became a Commission Merchant. He died Nov. 29, 1932.

His wife was Susanna E. Scarlett 27 Jan. 1853 Taylor County, Iowa. They were married 16 March 1871 in Atchison Co. Mo. She was a daughter of "Uncle" James Scarlett, by his first wife. She was quite crippled in her later years. She died 4 Sept. 1933.

Her children were Mamie Josephine 2 June 1872 who d. June 1951; Anna Lois 11 Aug. 1874 who d. 11 May 1924; James A. 24 Nov. 1876 who d. 15 Dec. 1877; Homer V. 1 Oct. 1878; Ruby Olive 27 Aug. 1881; Eunice E. 21 July 1883; Cecil 14 Dec. 1887; Jesse H. 11 Jan. 1893.

Homer V. VanGundy 1 Oct. 1878 Atch. Co. Mo. (Son of Alexander VanGundy 1850-1932). He died Dec. 11, 1956. He was a Motel Owner.

His wife was Allie Potoc of Falls City, Nebr. No children. Her last address McDonald Hill, Moses Lake, Wash.

Ruby O. VanGundy Aug. 27, 1881 Atch. Co. Mo. (Daughter of Alexander VanGundy 1850-1932). She died March 13, 1952. Her husband was Theodore Vincent Helmer, Sr. Dec. 26, 1876 Brownville, Nebr. They were married Oct. 23, 1904 at Cheyenne, Wyo. He was a merchant. Their one child was Theodore V. Helmer, Jr. Aug. 23, 1909. Note: Ruby's husband was later married to Mrs. Margaret Williams, a widow, at Longview, Wash. on Dec. 29, 1953.

Theodore Vincent Helmer, Jr. Aug. 23, 1909 Cheyenne, Wyo. (Son of Ruby O. VanGundy 1881-1952). He is a merchant; was a Captain in the U. S. Army in WW 2. Last address Bonners Ferry, Idaho. His wife was Helen F. Winterer of Carrington, N. Dak. They were married May 25, 1935 at Bonners Ferry, Idaho. Their one child, Ann Marie Helmer July 8, 1937, was married June 8, 1957 at Larned, Kans. to S/Sgt. James Jewell, who was stationed at Fairchild Air Base, Spokane, Wn. To them was born James Christopher Jewell March 20, 1958.

Eunice E. VanGundy July 21, 1883 (Daughter of Alexander VanGundy 1850-1932) She died August 14, 1951. Her husband was Wm. Preston Guild Aug. 11, 1873 Titusville, Pa. They were married Jan. 13, 1911 at Raton, N. Mexico. He died March 30, 1959. Their children were Jane Elizabeth Guild April 10, 1915 Cheyenne, Wyo.; and William P. Guild, Jr. May 21, 1920 Denver, Colo.

Jane Elizabeth Guild April 10, 1915 Cheyenne, Wyo. (Daughter of Eunice E. VanGundy 1883-1951). Husband is Charles Hobart Carrier May 3, 1922 Falmouth, Kentucky. They were married March 11, 1956. Last address 3294 Clay, San Francisco 18, Calif.

Cecil VanGundy Dec. 14, 1887 Atch. Co. Mo. (Son of Alexander VanGundy 1850-1932). Is a Civil Engineer. Address 1980 Hoyt, Lakewood 15, Colo. First wife Vera Farmor Feb. 19, 1900 Chicago, Ill. They were married Sept. 18, 1923 at Chicago, Ill. She died May 13, 1944. No children. Second wife Christine Ford Lommor March 19, 1911. They were married March 15, 1946 at Nashville, Tenn. No Children.

Josko H. VanGundy Jan. 11, 1893 (Son of Alexander VanGundy (1850-1932)). Is a Laborer. Last address Gen'l. Delivery, Moses Lake, Wash. His wife was Edna Doolittle. Divorced in 1925.

Mary E. VanGundy July 21, 1851 Ross Co. O. (Daughter of James VanGundy 1823-1907). Date of death not known. Husband was Albert Howard May 6, 1844 Adams County Ohio. They were married July 10, 1868. Date of death not known. Their children, all born in Atchison Co., Mo., were Lillie J. Howard Sept. 17, 1871; Nora A. Howard April 30, 1873; Cora M. Howard Dec. 17, 1874; Celestia B. Howard Oct. 25, 1876; Arthur I. Howard Nov. 30, 1879; Olive E. Howard April 11, 1881; Earl A. Howard May 3, 1883, who died June 6, 1884. Data on the families of these children not available.

Austin VanGundy June 21, 1856 Ross Co. O. (Son of James VanGundy 1823-1907). A man of dry wit and practical common sense. This compiler visited them during the late "gay nineties" at their farm home in the edge of Iowa about three miles from the little town of Blanchard. He died May 31, 1942 at Shenandoah, Iowa. His wife was Mary Belle Gray Dec. 28, 1857 Brown Co. Ohio. They were married April 18, 1880 at Tarkio, Mo. A woman of unusual energy and determination, she on one occasion hitched an unbroken colt into the team and drove it to town. Also, at times filled in as the bass in the church choir. She died November 30, 1951. Their children were Pearl J. 2-27-1881; Frederick Lytle 1-10-1883; Samuel Bryson 2-2-1886; Sallie Lucinda 12-16-1889; and Ruth Rachel 1-12-1897.

Pearl J. VanGundy 2-27-1881 Nodaway Co. Mo. (Daughter of Austin VanGundy 1856-1942). She died 2-28-1952. Her husband was Wm. M. Simpson 2-27-1875. They were married 11-23-1910 at Shenandoah, Iowa. They had a daughter, Mary Alice Simpson 12-3-1911 Omaha, Nebraska.

Frederick Lytle VanGundy 1-10-1883 Nodaway Co., Mo. (Son of Austin VanGundy 1856-1942). Died of a brain tumor 1-14-1959 at Sterling, Colo. Was a prominent farmer of Logan County, Colo. during his active life. Fred's wife was Mollie Manson 8-7-1886 Macedonia, Iowa. They were married 12-18-1919 at Shenandoah, Iowa. Their children were Sterling 7-22-1922; and twin sons named Donald Austin & Gerald Frederick born 6-2-1926.

Sterling VanGundy 7-22-1922 Shenandoah, Iowa (Son of Frederick Lytle VanGundy 1883-1959). His wife is Marlyn Anno Tickner. Their children are David Allen 11-13-1947; Bruce Gray 4-11-1949; and Lynno Luise 10-30-1953.

His first wife was Mary Ann Jones 5-12-1832 Ross Co., O. Married 3-31-1853. She died 12-17-1882 in Atch. Co., Mo.  
Her children were Rosanna 2-15-1854; Wm. Austin 10-31-1855; John Wesley 4-11-1858 Ross Co. O. who d. 12-25-1867 in Atch. Co.; Emily 12-3-1860; Jane 10-19-1862; David Sherman 4-2-1865; Eliza 2-7-1867; James Watson 5-22-1869 who died 9-10-1870.
