Funeral rites held for Judith Murphy

Judith Holcomb was born in Clay County, West Virginia on September 9, 1886 the tenth of eleven children born to Pascal and Nancy Elizabeth Holcomb. She was the last living member of this family.

At the age of sixteen, she was baptized into the Methodist Church in which she remained active until ill health prevented her participation.

In 1905 she was united in marriage to Marion Monroe Murphy, also of Clay County, West Virginia. Four children were born to this union, Philip, Constance, Max and Nancy.

The family homesteaded in the community in 1910. In 1927 they returned to West Virginia, where Mrs. Murphy helped care for her ailing mother. They returned to Karval in 1930, moving to Hugo in 1937.

Mr. Murphy passed away in 1947, and Mrs. Murphy moved to Aurora, where she has since made her home.

In 1952 she married Frank Wood of Akron. This marriage ended in a divorce in 1956.

She had been in ill health for many years with heart disease and complications. She passed away in St. Luke Hospital, March 7, 1972, following a two-week hospitalization.

Two children also preceded her in death, Philip and Constance. She is survived by her son, Max and wife Vaultie, of Ohio, and daughter Nancy and her husband Eugene Jensen of Aurora; four grandchildren, Mrs. Judy Douglas, Ed Murphy and Janet Murphy of Ohio and Karen Kennedy of Northglenn; two great grandchildren, Lori and Doug, also of Ohio, as well as numerous nieces and nephews and many friends.

Funeral services were held Friday, March 10, 1972, at 2:30 p.m. in the United Methodist church, Hugo, with the Rev. Eric Talla officiating.

"The Last Mile of the Way" and "Peace in the Valley" were sung by Mrs. KorDova Lockwood and Mrs. Dixie Rose Igou with Mrs. Marilyn Stone at the piano.

THOMAS HOLCOMBE¹⁸ was the first Holcombe to come to the United States of America. He had attended Haynes University and had been a soldier for England. He sailed from Plymouth, County Devon, England, one of a company of Puritans and Dissenters who assembled in the new hospital there, with Bishops John Maverick and John Wareham. In March 1630, after a day of prayer and fasting, these Bishops were chosen as officers and the "MARY AND JOHN," a four hundred ton ship, was chartered by Captain Squeb for their voyage to America. After a seventy day voyage they arrived May 30, 1630 at Nantasket, Massachusetts. Ten of the men procured a boat and scouted for the best place to make their home in the New World, but other members of their company discovered a location at Mattapan on the Charles River, now in Suffolk County, Massachusetts. Here was pasture for their famished cattle. They came ashore on the south side of Dorchester Neck in the "Old Harbour," now South Boston. They named their settlement "Dorchester" for the town they had left in Old England, and it is still called by this name, as part of Boston.

The church records of Colonial New England are quite complete and indicate the intense religious devotion of our Puritan ancestors. The church at Simsbury, Hartford County, Connecticut, had the same Pastor from 1697 to 1710 and a membership of twenty six men and seventeen women. Among its members were Thomas Barber, Peter Buell, Samuel Case, THOMAS HOLCOMBE¹⁹, Thomas Griffen, John Case, NATHANIEL HOLCOMBE²⁰, Mascalin an Indian, RUTH HOLCOMBE, Mary Bissell, Elizabeth Fuller, and HANNA HOLCOMBE.

THOMAS HOLCOMBE¹⁹ settled in Dorchester, Massachusetts, in a house which he owned in 1633, and sold by deed August 12, 1635 to Richard Jones, signing "THOMAS HOLCOMBE" and including four tracts amounting to twenty one acres. In a lottery there on December 1, 1634, THOMAS drew land and was made a Freeman March 14, 1634. The form of his oath as Freeman is preserved.

He with sixty "Puritans and Dissenters" joined Reverend Wareham in the immigration in 1635-1636 to the junction of the Farmington and Connecticut Rivers, where they founded Windsor. Among the prominent immigrant families associated with

THOMAS HOLCOMBE¹⁸ were John Webster, Governor of Connecticut, Deacon Samuel Chapin, one of the founders of Springfield, Massachusetts, Honorable William Phelps, one of the Commissioners appointed by the Massachusetts Bay Colony in 1636 to govern Connecticut, member of the Council in the Pequot War of 1637, and in framing the Constitution of 1639, Captain Joseph Wadsworth, who concealed the Charter of Connecticut in the "Charter Oak," General Nathan Johnson, Officer in the War of 1812, State Senator, Quartermaster General for years, and prominent lawyer.

THOMAS HOLCOMBE¹⁹, farmer, represented Windsor and Hartford County, Connecticut on the General Court; served for both at Hartford in framing the Constitution of the Colony of Connecticut and as Deputy in 1649. He was born in 1601, and died 7 September 1657 in Windsor, Hartford County, Connecticut. He married about 1632, ELIZABETH FERGUSON, born in Wales, who also came to America on the Ship "Mary and John" March 20 to May 30, 1630. She married 3 August 1658, James Eno. She died 7 October 1679, at Simsbury, Hartford County, Connecticut.

THE HOLCOMBE FAMILY of Connecticut gave forty nine of her sons as soldiers in the American Revolution. Most of them were from Hartford County, and all of them were related.*

*It is not our intention here to give more than our direct line from our immigrant ancestor, THOMAS HOLCOMBE¹⁹. A complete history of the Holcombes may be found in "The Holcombes, Nation Builders," by Elizabeth, a descendant of the Holcombes, and Lewis D. McPherson.
