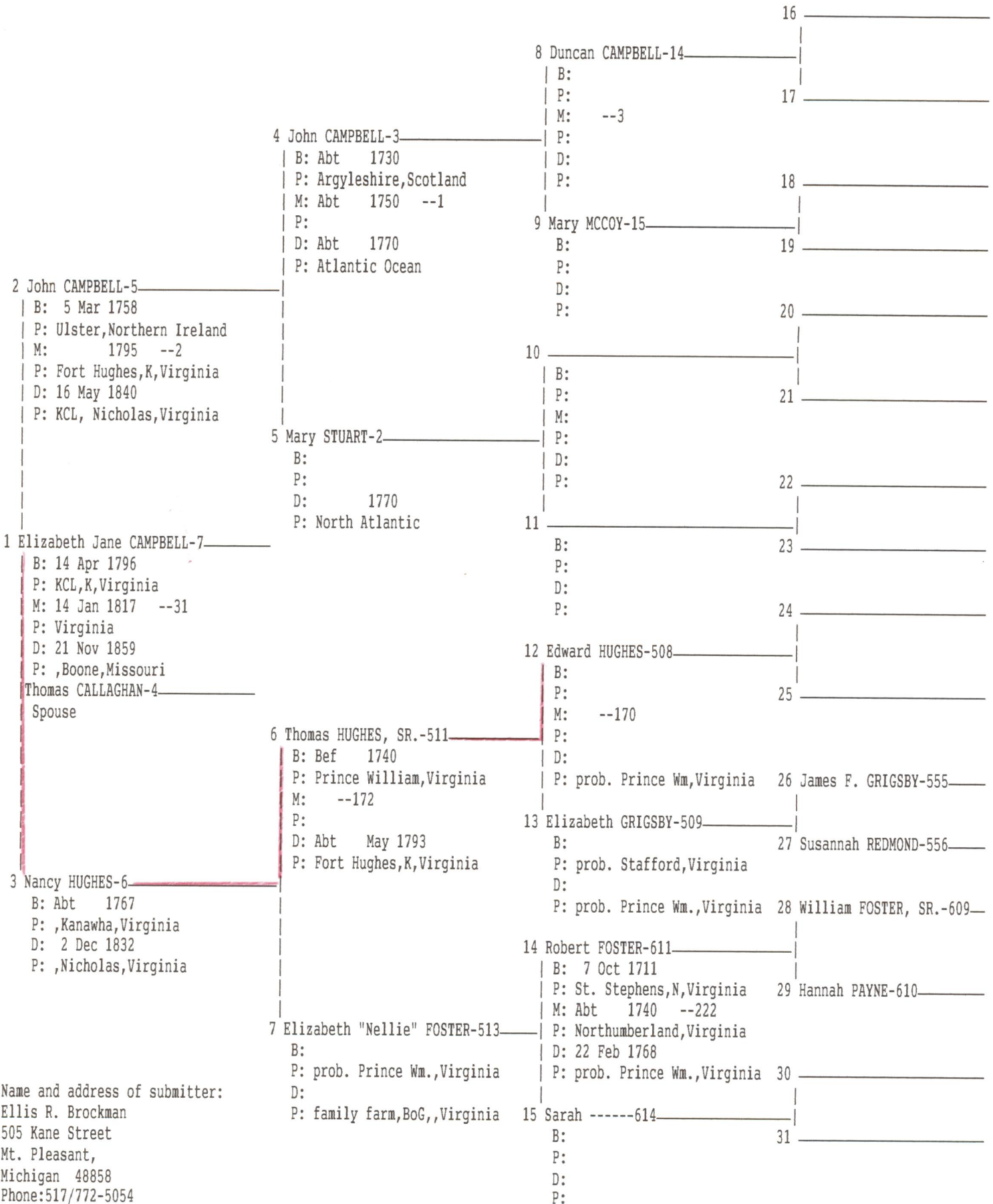

HUSBAND - John CAMPBELL-5

John Campbell came to America about 1770. The ship he sailed on from Belfast, Northern Ireland was possibly the S.S. Humbolt. His parents died during the voyage to America and John was about 12 years old when he came to New York.

John Campbell (Cambel) was a 2nd Lieut. in the "Flying Camp" from Lancaster county, PA during the Revolutionary War. This unit was commanded by Col. Cunningham. John Campbell's name appears on a return dated 5 Oct 1776, signed by "Col. C.S. Adams, Maj. Gen." "The Adjutant Gen. by W.L."

John Campbell went to Kanawha county, VA at or near the close of the Revolutionary War; he was a Kanawha Rifleman on border patrol, with headquarters at the mouth of Hughes Creek, now Hugheston, under the command of Thomas Hughes, also a Revolutionary War soldier.

John, his wife, and several children and grandchildren were buried in the small cemetery, Military Cemetery, located near Kessler's Cross Lanes in Nicholas county, WV.

Anytime "KCL" is noted for this family it stands for Kesslers Cross Lanes.

Edward Campbell was born to John and Nancy (Hughes) Campbell 22 Aug 1800 in a cabin on the headwaters of Whitewater River in the Kanawha Valley of VA (now WV). Edward, often referred to as Colonel or Judge Campbell, taught school in Nicholas County, for a number of years and was a solid, pioneer historian of the county. He was also a Justice of the Peace for the county and became known as a "traveling judge" because his duties often required him to travel long distances throughout the county.

Edward Campbell was connected with the organization of Zoar Baptist Church;

he donated the land for both the church and the adjoining cemetery. He was also active in the church at Alloy in Fayette county, WV.

Edward was a confederate soldier in the Civil War. He was captured by Union forces and was a prisoner at Camp Chase in Ohio. Upon his release he held the rank of colonel in the CSA.

As previously mentioned, Edward Campbell was a historian of Nicholas County, WV. In 1883 he wrote a series of 12 letters about the settlement of the county. These letters were first published in the newspaper, The Nicholas Chronicle, in 1883. They were republished by the paper in 1892 and again in 1933.

Edward Campbell's first wife was Margaret Bell Masterson. They were married on 14 Dec 1826. She was born at Blue Sulphur in Greenbrier County, VA and was a daughter of Thomas and Jane (McClung) Masterson. Jane McClung (1776 to 1834) was a daughter of Joseph McClung and Miss Bell. Thomas Masterson was a Revolutionary War soldier. Margaret had ten children, seven sons and three daughters. She died 29 Sep 1849 in Nicholas County. Edward's second wife was Susan Dunkle of Bridgewater, VA; they were married 20 Jun 1856. Susan was born 8 May 1800 to John and Sally Dunkle. No children were born to this second marriage. Susan died 20 Oct 1883 of dropsy. Both of her parents were originally from PA.

Edward Campbell died 29 Jan 1886 in Nicholas County, WV. He was buried in the cemetery of the Zoar Baptist Church.

Mary died young of typhoid fever. She is buried in an unmarked grave in the Military Cemetery at Kessler's Cross Lanes, Nicholas county, WV. Mary was engaged to marry Jacob Dotson, a carpenter/cabinet maker who came to Cross Lanes with Kessler. Jacob made Mary's coffin.

3. No tombstone or death notice are known for the two children (Alexander and Emeline) buried in the Military Cemetery at Kessler Cross Lanes in Nicholas county, WV.
4. Robert Campbell was a farmer in VA/WV, IL and MO.
5. Robert and Eliza were in Seneca township, post office Woodstock, in McHenry county Illinois.
6. It is possible that they were in Knox county, IL, about 1867, before moving to Cass county, MO.
7. They lived in Sugar Creek township, post office Dayton, in Cass county, MO.
8. Robert and Eliza were both members of the M.E. Church South in Cass county.
9. Toward the end of his life, Robert sold the farm in Cass county and moved to a house in Garden City, Cass county, MO.
10. No grave has been located in Cass county for Robert or any member of his family.
11. No obituary was seen in a survey of the Cass County Democrat newspaper.
